Guthrie House
Outreach clinic and multi service building in Elgin where they offer support to vulnerable people living in North Leeds.

Community & Primary Health Care
Adult day services, in-home respite services, support and counselling, Music & Memories luncheon, Meals on Wheels, Diners Club.

Volunteer Centre of St. Lawrence-Rideau
Provides leadership opportunities and training to volunteers in non profit organizations.

Prescott Youth Centre
Provides a supervised, safe, drug-free environment for youth aged 8-18. Free access to activities (cooking club, homework help, computer and internet access, games).

Girls Incorporated of Upper Canada
Provides programming and workshops for girls aged 6-18 including: Friendly PEERSuasion, Media & Me, Be BOLD, Action for Safety, Living Safe & Strong.

The Brockville & District Association for Community Involvement
Provides a variety of services and opportunities for people with intellectual disabilities to participate in community life; including education employment, housing, family support, recreation and advocacy.

Connect Youth
Bridges gaps in services for youth through advocacy, referrals and support for at-risk youth.

Lanark, Leeds & Grenville Addictions & Mental Health
Therapeutic recreation program for those recovering from mental illness and addictions (wellness, social, recreational and life skills).

Boys and Girls Club of Kingston
After school programs, youth program and summer camps (Gananoque and Brockville).

Mentoring the youth in our community through traditional match & site based programs, in-school mentoring, Go Girls, Game On and Wellington After School program.

Youth Volunteer Crew

Family & Children's Services of Lanark Leeds & Grenville
Provides child protection and family support services (family counselling, motivational speakers, after school program, leadership development).
